

## **Mandatory**

### **Registered NDIS** providers

Clearance required for all staff in 'risk assessed' roles

- Direct support workers
- Key personnel (includes **CEO and Board Members**)
- Anyone with more than 'incidental' contact

# **Optional**

Unregistered **NDIS** providers

**People directly hiring** their own supports (Plan & Self-Managed NDIS funding)

**Screening Check:** Whether an NDIS worker poses an unacceptable risk of harm to people with disability

- Workers are either 'cleared' or 'excluded'.
- Applicant receives a Worker Screening ID number, not a card.
- Check is portable across roles and organisations. Valid for use in all Australian states and territories for up to 5 years.
- Check is ongoing. New information may trigger a reassessment of the worker's clearance.
- In WA, screening is done by Department of Communities, NDIS Worker Screening Unit: www.ndiswsu.wa.gov.au

**National Database:** 

Up-to-date record of NDIS worker clearances across Australia

- Database is managed by the NDIS Quality and Safeguards Commission.
- Employers use the Database to validate their worker's application for the Check and to link to workers to be automatically notified of any changes to their clearance.
- Registered providers access the Database via PRODA.
- People directly hiring their own supports and Unregistered providers can access the Database but need to apply.

The National Police Certificate (NPC) may also be required by an employer.

In addition to any other checks, Working with Children Check is mandatory for any worker in 'child-related work' unless an exemption applies.
